WHEREAS life and property remain at risk due to the flooding event that took place in *Electoral Area D/Rural Grand Forks, Regional District of Kootenay Boundary (RDKB)*;


AND WHEREAS response to this risk due to the flooding event continues to require use of the emergency powers to regulate persons or property to protect the health, safety or welfare of people or to limit damage to property for the following;

5925 Danish Road (bank instability)
2495 Almond Gardens Road (bank instability)
10020 North Fork Road (no access due to re-direction of Granby River)

and the Manly Meadows Road area due to loss of access due to re-direction of the Kettle River along Manly Meadows Road for the following addresses and legal descriptions:


